## **PROBLEM**

Existing healthcare systems do not always meet the specialized demands for Veterans regarding perinatal care. Services are scattered between the Veterans Health Administration (VHA), Community Care or not available at all. Veterans must pay out of pocket and request reimbursement for such services as lactation counseling covered under the Maternity Care benefits



#### **SOLUTION**

Perinatal Reproductive Education Planning and Resources (PREPARe) is a multi-disciplinary approach to perinatal care that engages diverse staff Offering a wide array of services nurtures longevity in breastfeeding. reduction in symptoms of perinatal mood and anxiety disorders, and
