Are you a busy clinician looking for high-quality continuing education without the need for travel? Specialty Care Veterans Administration Extension for Community Healthcare Outcomes (VA-ECHO) has got you covered! VA-ECHO offers live webinars in 23 specialties that combine specialty consultation with case-based accredited didactic education, creating a learning community through mentorship that promotes evidence-based, Veteran-centered care.

In fiscal year (FY) 2022, Specialty Care VA-ECHO provided over 50,000 contact hours to over 9,000 learners from 611 VA sites in all 50 states plus Guam, American Samoa and Puerto Rico. And the best part? VA-ECHO currently offers two programs in partnership with the Simulation Learning, Evaluation, Assessment, and Research Network (SimLEARN) including SimLEARN Community of Practice (CoP) & Resuscitation Education and Innovation (REdI) 2 Rescue.

Both programs have received positive comments from evaluations, and upcoming sessions cover a variety of topics such as suicide simulation challenges, difficult airway management, tracheostomy care and implicit bias in interprofessionalism.

Multi-session workshops and multi-day boot camps with interactive question and answer and/or expert-led panel discussions are also available. All live sessions offer ACCME, ACCME-NP, ACPE and ANCC accreditations, and additional accreditations are offered as appropriate such as AAPA, ABIM-MOC, ACHE, ADA, AOTA, APA, APTA, ASHA, ASWB-NYSED, CDR, CRCE, JA-ICPE, NBCC and PACE.
